## Media Release Protective Services Officers at Frankston

With Protective Services Officers (PSOs) now patrolling Frankston Train Station, Peninsula Community Legal Centre is urging commuters to be aware of their rights.

Principal Lawyer, Victoria Mullings, says:

"PSOs are armed and uniformed officers who have the power to apprehend, arrest, search, fine and ask people to move on in designated areas such as trains stations and surrounding areas. PSOs have broad powers but they must interact with commuters in an accountable manner that is compliant with the duties and restrictions placed on them by the legislation.

For example, when dealing with PSOs you have the right to request their name, address, place of duty, or ask to see identification if they are not in uniform. If asked, you must provide a PSO with your name and address but beyond that you are not obliged to answer any other questions. Commuters should remember that any information they give a PSO may be used against them in court.

Anyone seeking more information about their rights in dealing with PSOs is encouraged to visit our Centre at 441 Nepean Highway to collect a free information card. This information card has been produced by the Federation of Community Legal Centres in partnership with Smart Justice and the Mental Health Legal Service, as part of the *Your Rights on Track* campaign. We encourage anyone with concerns about their treatment by PSOs to seek legal advice at the earliest opportunity."
