Conflict of Interest Information

What is a Conflict of Interest?

Lawyers are not able to act for both parties in a dispute.

A conflict arises where the Centre has access to information which would prevent us from being able to act in your best interest. This may mean that we have seen the other party for some reason in the past, or it may be due to other factors.

Where possible we will search our records prior to advice being given to ensure that a conflict of interest does not exist.

If a conflict exists or we become aware of a conflict while we are assisting you, we must refer you elsewhere, usually to another community legal centre, Victoria Legal Aid or a private lawyer.
