WHAT IS A **CONFLICT OF INTEREST?**

Lawyers are not able to act for both parties in a matter.

A conflict arises where the centre has access to information which would prevent us from being able to act in your best interest. This may mean that we have seen the other party for some reason in the past, or may be due to other factors.

Where possible we will search our records prior to advice being given to ensure that a conflict of interest does not exist.

If a conflict of interest is identified or we become aware of a conflict while assisting you, we must refer you elsewhere, usually to another community legal centre, Victoria Legal Aid or a private lawyer.

In some circumstances conflicts will expire "after a period of time".

All community legal centres, Legal Aid and private lawyers follow Conflict of Interest guidelines.

If you are advised that there is a conflict of interest, it does not mean that we do not want to help you, it means that we can't help you for professional reasons.
